### *CD/Daf or DVD/Daf:*

A computer CD-ROM or DVD that displays the *daf* on a computer screen, Cd/Daf or DVD/Daf enables the learner to click on references on the *daf* and to display the reference in context (*psukim*, other *gemarahs*, *Rambam*, *Tur*, *Shulchan Aruch*). It allows the user to listen to audio *shiurim* on the *daf* in English, Hebrew and Yiddish. It can also display selected *meforshim* on the *daf*. CD/Daf audio only version is also available. אין יום שבת... (The text is a dense Yiddish article discussing the completion of the first cycle of Daf Yomi in 1931, written by Rabbi Meir Shapiro. It details the historical context and the significance of the event.)

Reflections of Rabbi Meir Shapiro, zt"l,

on the Completion of the First Cycle of Daf Yomi  
(Address translated from the Yiddish newspaper Dos Yiddische Tagblatt, February 2, 1931)

On the first day of Rosh Hashanah 5684, Jews across the world took the first Mesechta of Gemara in their hands and began to study it. And, now, the 15th day of שבט, 5691, behold, they are up to the very last Gemara of Shas at the **Siyum HaShas**.

Two thousand seven hundred and two days have gone by, and on each succeeding day, a daf was turned. When we take an overview of the harmonious combination of the dafim and the days – we arrive at the same number — 2702.

השונה הלכות בכל יום

What extraordinary patience a Jew possesses! After a day-long wrestle in a sea of travails, he immerses his soul in the sea of the Talmud, and his bitter daily existence is transformed into living halachos. אל תקרי הליכות אלא הלכות. He is troubled and buffeted by the wild chaotic daily grind; however his blatt Gemara prevails over all. It is the bridge of paper on which he traverses the sea of the world; this bridge is mightier than any mechanical bridge.

The strongest magnetic force of the Daf Yomi is the knowledge that the very same daf that he is learning, is being studied by others around the world. Each one with his unique approach and individualized pronunciation – but the same אביי and רבא.

I rightly sensed what the Daf Yomi bequeathed to the world on my world travels for the benefit of the Yeshiva. There I encountered the study of the Daf Yomi in Jewish communities. The difference in the style of learning the Daf Yomi by Dr. Bronzweig in Strasbourg or Reb Isser Assistant in London or Rabbi Schwartz in Baltimore fades completely when compared to the all-encompassing power of the Daf Yomi concept. Whatever the pronunciation, the essence is the same.

It's still fresh in my memory, the response of the soldier, Yechiel Yeshaya of Radom, in whose small valise I happened to notice a small Gemara – the Gemara of the Daf Yomi. In response to my question as to whether he studies daily, I received a simple answer: "Of course – I'm a soldier, and I do not move away from my Daf Yomi position."

Yes! How True!! An important position. We have ב"ה assumed a position that is very significant in our struggle for survival.

Today our position is stronger, our ranks have swelled; everyone, without exception, stands ready to uphold the Daf Yomi position.

Today is the טוב of יום of ישראל. כלל. Fortunate feel those who have studied the daily daf and those that support its learning.

Each and everyone here embraces the great hope that they will be able to undertake the second cycle of Shas under better circumstances.

Today, the 2702 blatt that have been learned by tens of thousands of Jews, (may their numbers increase) arise and stand before the כסא הכבוד as trusty advocates for the Jewish salvation according to the assurance of our Sages.
